AT KILMAINHAN IN 2010....

About Us

- *Kilmainhan* was established with the delivery of a commercial herd consisting of a bull, cows and calves and heifers on 6 June 1996. Since that time we had improved our herd with the selective purchase of animals from a number of studs, primarily from Willalooka.
- We have MN3 status under the Australian Cattle Johnne's Disease Market Assurance Program (MAP) Cert No 228.
- Our pregnancy testing, general animal health issues and MAP are managed by Willunga Vet Services.
- We occasionally show at country shows to receive the judge's feedback and at the Adelaide Royal Show in 2008 being the Murray Grey Breed Speciality.
- In conjunction with Willunga High School we participate in the Adelaide Royal Show steer competition where we did well again in 2009 placing second in the export steer category.
- Our stock is sold through the Beef Field Days, young stock directly to feedlots, older animals are sold by private treaty, and remaining stock to T&R Pastoral at Murray Bridge.

Our Herd

- Our objective is to:
 - Produce high performance seed stock which are able to meet most market requirements;
 - Emphasize fertility by restricting joining periods;
 - Produce cattle with moderate birth weight, high growth, muscularity with good fat cover and carcass qualities.
- Our cattle are raised on grass with seasonal supplemental feeding with hay with stud and commercial females raised together.
- Depending upon the year we run about 50 cows with calves along with separate groups of heifers and young bulls.
- Bulls are vaccinated with 7 in 1 vaccination and have been drenched.
- We actively participate in the Murray Grey Group Breedplan and our results this year show consistent top rankings in the Junior Sire Lists and overall improvement across all indexes.

Property Improvement

- As part of our program of continuous improvement we again engaged Pro Ag Consulting to assist us with pasture management to maximise the genetic potential of our herd and the productivity of our pasture. This partnership has been particularly valuable in adjusting to the new climatic conditions we have been experiencing at Mt Jagged.
- Our hay cut was proof that it is not only how much rain you get but also when the rain comes. We put away some 150 bales this year with some paddocks yielding 9 large bales to the acre.
- The herd has renewed its registration at MN3 under the Australian Cattle Johns Disease Market Assurance Program passing an external audit in addition to the testing processes.
- Peter completed and passed his ChemCert Accreditation Course to improve his knowledge and skills to use pesticides and veterinary medicines in a way that is safe to him, other people and the environment.
- Some of our large pines have been removed due to age and to reduce the fire risk and new flower garden beds planted out in their place which are slowly being taken over by Peter's vegetables.
